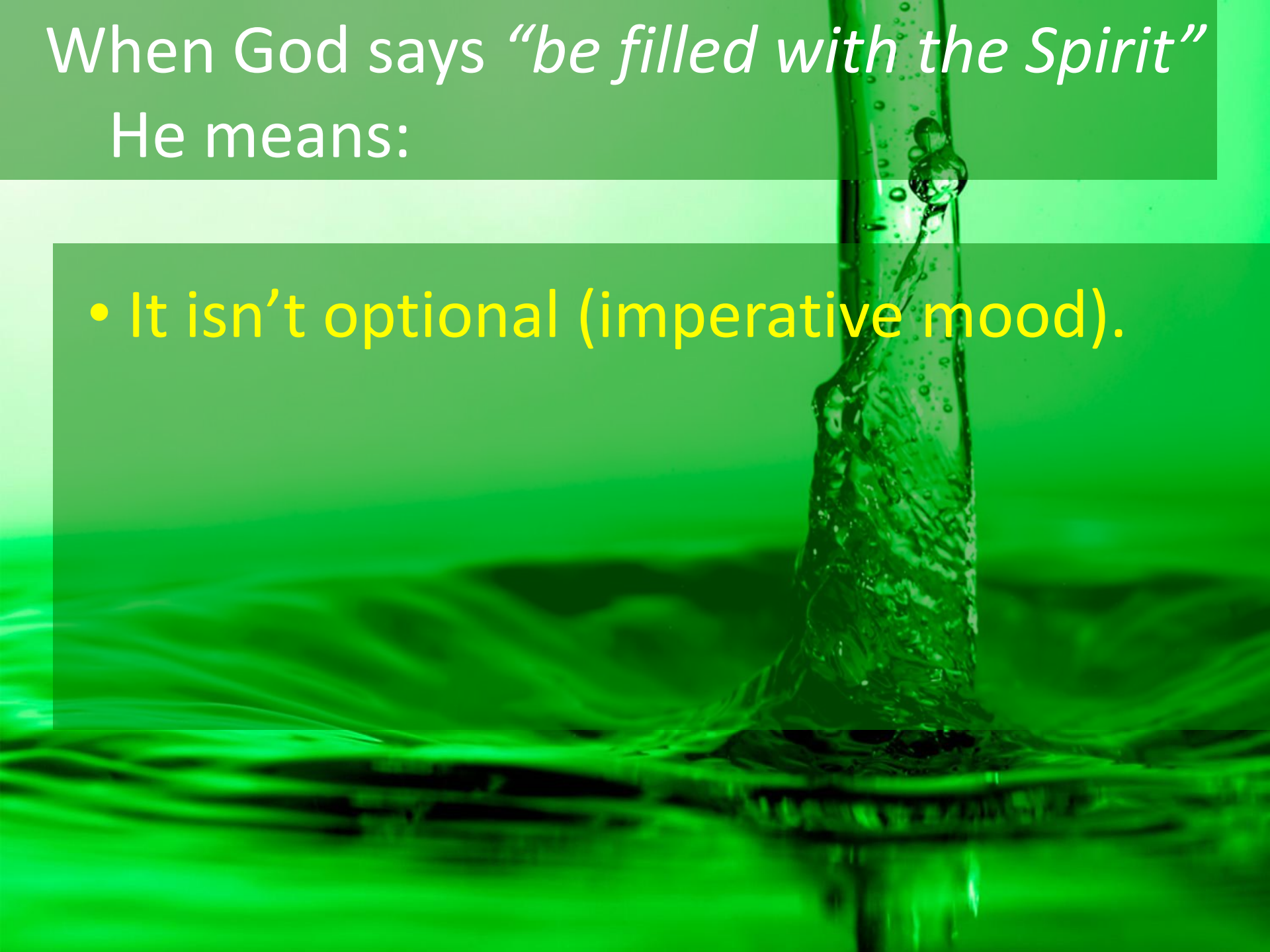

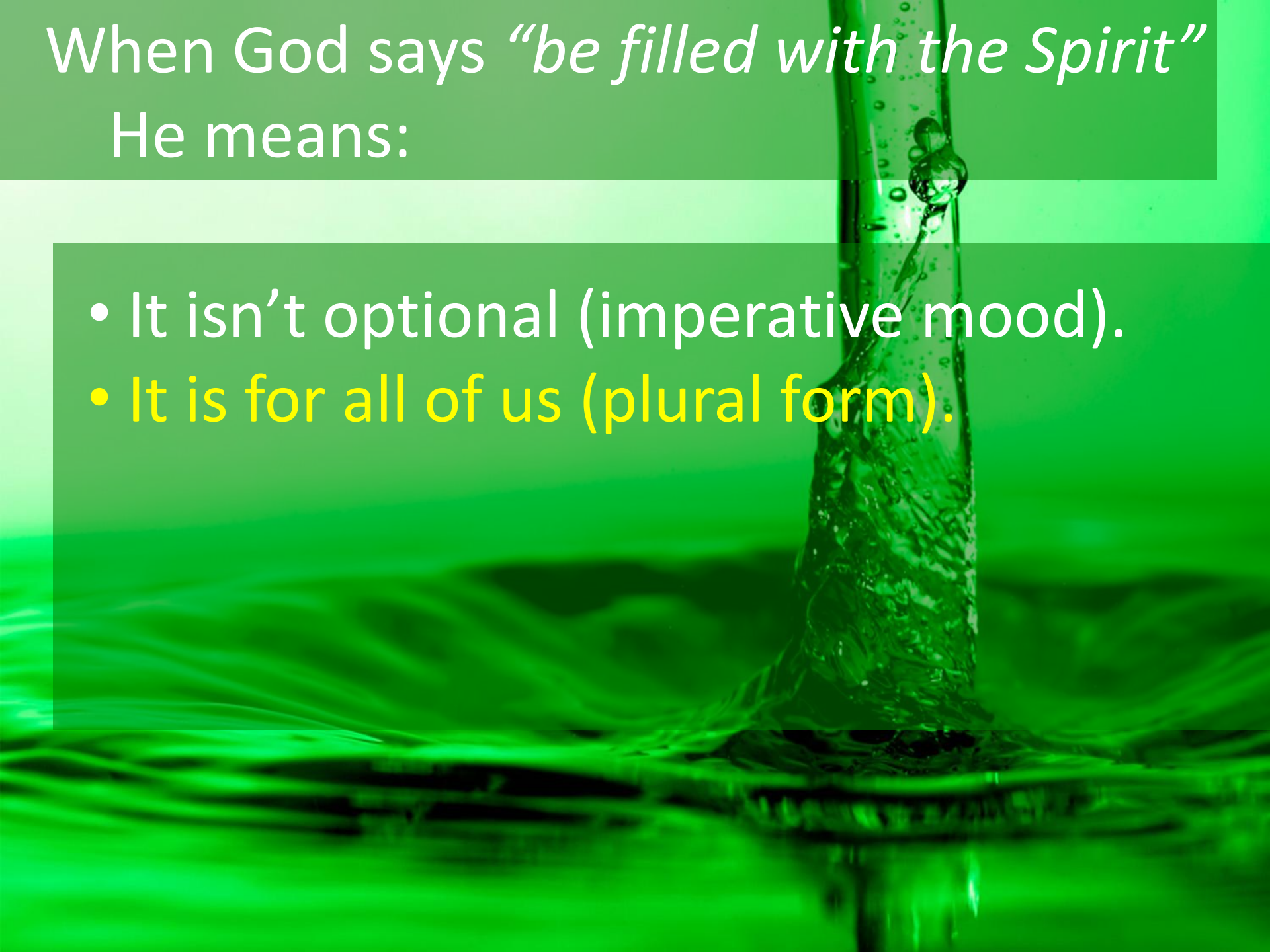

- It is a repeated event (present tense)

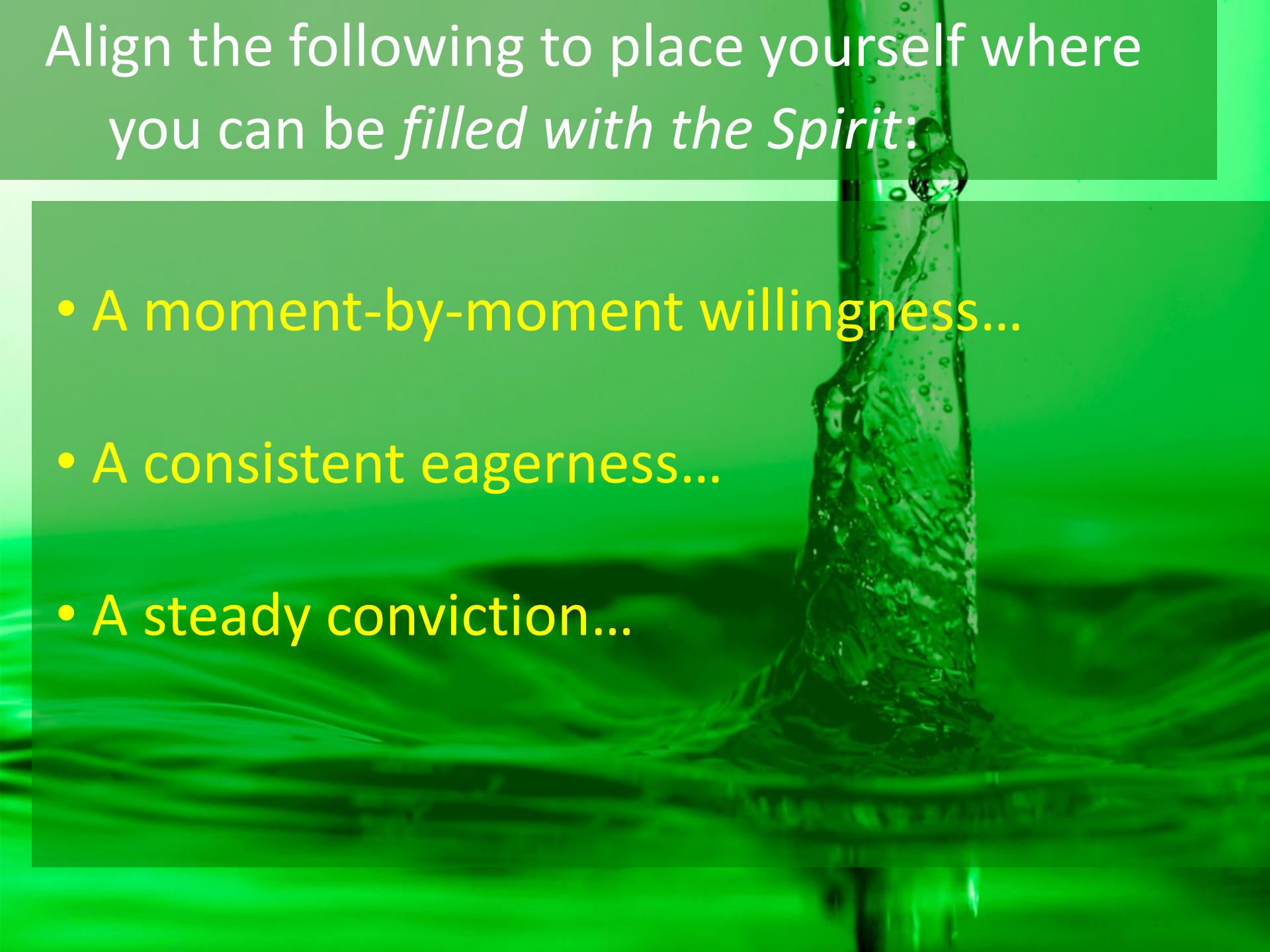


To be *filled with the Spirit...*
